- 3. Service Details:
- The scope of services may include but is not limited to:
- Regular maintenance checks
- Emergency repairs at regular rates
- 10% discount on replacement of parts and components
- Priority service
- System diagnostics and troubleshooting
- 4. Service Frequency:

- Regular maintenance visits will be scheduled as per the agreed-upon frequency, typically annually. Spring for Cooling, Fall for Heating. Emergency services will be available 24/7.

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- 5. Fees and Payment:
- The customer agrees to pay fees based on selection within 30 days of the invoice date.
- The customer account must be current.
- 6. Termination:

- Either party may terminate the contract with written notice if the other party breaches any material term of the agreement. In the event of termination, the customer remains responsible for any outstanding payments. Service agreements are non-refundable.
